

A super-wide shade with a low profile.

MagnaShade is a super-wide, motorized roller shade. It does the work of multiple shade bands without the light gaps and seams. But unlike conventionally wide shades, **MagnaShade** maintains a low profile. That's because its modular design adds rigid support to the shade tube without increasing the diameter.

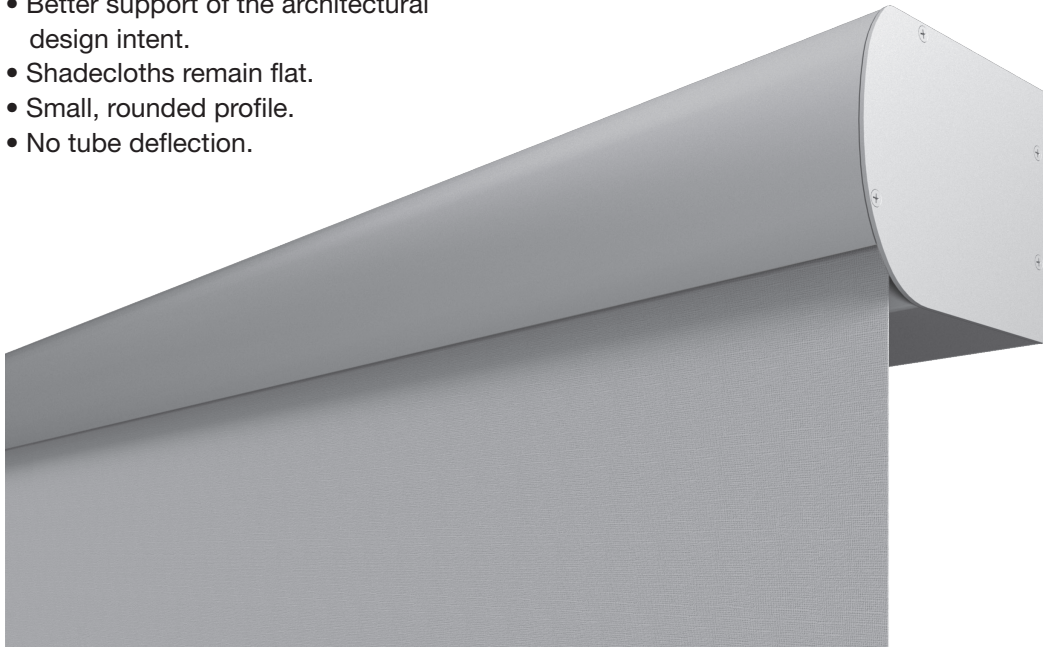
Key features:

- Shading or blackout at widths between 15 ft. (4.5m) and 40 ft. (12m).
- Available with a variety of shade cloths.
- Better support of the architectural design intent.
- Shade cloths remain flat.
- Small, rounded profile.
- No tube deflection.

Basic components:

- Backplate.
- Shade cloth.
- Shade cradle.
- Front and bottom fascias.

The backplate fastens to the ceiling or wall. Multiple attachment points across the span add support. The shade cradle hooks top-edge-first onto the backplate, and lowers into place, taking jack screws along the bottom. Fascia conceals the cradle from the bottom and across the front.
